

REFEREE'S GAME SHEET CHECKLIST

It is hectic after the game, so please arrive 30 minutes before the game to complete the following:

- Get 3 game sheets from each team.
- Count the number of Team Officials per team and compare to the sheet.
- Count the number of players per team and compare it to the sheet.
- Ask Team Officials to do the Player Identification and initial the sheet as required.
- Indicate if there is a game delay being caused and by whom, if yes.
- Indicate if there is a protest being filed and by whom, if yes.
- Check that two proper nets and four corner flags were provided by the home team.
- Check that there is no uniform clash and ask the home team to change if there is.
- PRINT your name and Assistant Referees' names on the sheet neatly, if it is not already there.

DURING THE GAME

- Players arriving late must be verified by an opposing Team Official. Development-aged players may join the game at any time. Competitive-aged players must arrive before half-time to play.
- Any number changes to jerseys must be cleared by you and noted on the game sheet neatly (*goalie plays out, jersey has blood on it*).
- If any other team officials arrive late, they must be on the game sheet.

AFTER THE GAME

- Indicate goal scorers and cards for Competitive-aged teams.
- Indicate the final score at the top of the game sheet for Competitive-aged teams.
- Have Team Officials sign the sheets if they haven't already.
- Give one pair of sheets to each team and keep the third pair for yourself. Double check!
- Upload photos of game sheets to RefCentre within 24 hours. One photo for each game sheet.
- Keep ALL game sheets until the end of the season.

Use a folder or a clipboard to keep game sheets together. Have a waterproof bag to put them in if it is rainy. Have more than one pen in your referee bag.

You are being paid per game, not per hour, and it is expected that you arrive at the field with time to complete all of the before and after game tasks.
